Practice good hand-washing 1 Prepare supplies 2 Disconnect and flush 3 De-access port 4
STEP 1: PRACTICE GOOD HAND-WASHING
Always remember to <b>WASH YOUR HANDS</b> for a full 20 seconds when instructed.
STEP 2: PREPARE SUPPLIES
Check through the carry bag to be certain your infusion is complete. If it is not, wait a little longer and/or contact your pharmacy for direction.
U WASH HANDS.
Clean workspace with cleaning solution (alcohol/sanitizing wipes or Lysol + paper towels). WASH HANDS.
Gather supplies: 2 pairs chemo gloves; chemo gown; 1 clear hazard zip lock and 1 large hazard bag; 4 alcohol pads; 1 saline syringe; chemo sharps container; 1 regular trash bag. WASH HANDS.
Prepare supplies: Unwrap saline, remove bubbles; all other items within hands reach.
Have a trash bag ready for your regular garbage disposal.
STEP 3: DISCONNECT AND FLUSH
<b>WASH HANDS.</b> Put on Chemo gown. Put on two pairs of gloves. Gown cuffs over gloves.
Remove pump and chemo bag from carry bag. Stop and power down the pump.
Remove cassette and discard in chemo sharps container.
<ul> <li>Scrub the hub and attach the saline syringe to the blue end cap. Flush the line with normal saline in pulsatile fashion;</li> <li>Discard syringe in garbage. Do the same if the line requires Heparin flush as well. Dispose of used syringe in the garbage.</li> </ul>
STEP 4: DE-ACCESS PORT
Expose the insertion site of the needle by removing the dressing. Be careful not to move the needle a lot.
Anchor the port with two fingers of one hand and pull the needle straight out or pinch the wings together to remove.
Remove gown and gloves careful not to expel particulate into the air.
Place gown and gloves in clear zip lock and seal closed.
Place zip lock in larger hazard bag and seal with zip tie. Place in storage out of the way.
