

4. Membership

There are three levels of membership. Please choose the option that best applies to you.

Option 1: Full Membership

Please Choose Clinical or Research

- Research

This option requires the applicant to be a PI or Co-PI on at least 1 cell engineering or regenerative medicine related peer-reviewed and funded research project award. For new and junior faculty, this requirement can be waived for up to two years. Applicant must also have at least one cell engineering related peer-reviewed publication within the last three years.

- Clinical

This option requires the applicant to have authorship on cell engineering related clinical trials and/or accrual of patients to cell engineering related clinical trials and/or have a leadership role in cooperative group studies.

Option 2: Associate Membership

- This option is for applicants who are faculty or staff involved in fulfilling the mission of the ICE through research or education but do not currently meet the full membership requirements.

Option 3: Honorary Membership

- This option is for applicants who are Department Chairs or Institutional leaders who are not actively involved in cell engineering research but frequently collaborate with ICE and are considered instrumental in achieving ICE's research mission.
