#### **Focus Area**

Johns Hopkins Health Plans' primary focus area for funding is to address *Social Determinants of Health and Wellbeing*, including:

- Food insecurity: fresh food access and education about healthy food choices for the entire family
- Healthy aging in place: supportive programs to prioritize and empower senior health
- Programs that educate, empower, and support families and communities to better understand and care for the mental health of youth.

## **Application Process**

- Johns Hopkins Health Plans is accepting grant applications to fund meaningful programs that can be tracked/monitored and have proven outcomes.
- Local non-profit organizations are invited to apply for a grant up to \$20,000 by completing the enclosed application.
- Grantees must be a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Johns Hopkins entities are not eligible. Applications will be reviewed and scored with a decision made within 30-45 days. Submit applications to <a href="mailto:Communityrelations@jhhp.org">Communityrelations@jhhp.org</a> (Community Relations office at Johns Hopkins Health Plans).
- Organization will be notified whether the award is approved or declined.

### **Evaluation guidelines:**

- The requesting organization should align with the mission of Johns Hopkins Health Plans, which is to empower people on their journey to good health.
- Grant amount will be determined by need and alignment of mission and focus area.
