

Parkinson's Disease Research Brain Donation Registry

Individuals with Parkinson's disease or related movement disorders (such as Lewy Body Disease) are being recruited to participate in a brain donation program funded by the NIH through the Morris K. Udall Parkinson's Disease Research Center of Excellence at Johns Hopkins. Individuals with no history of a brain disorder may also participate as a control.

Registration in the brain donation program enables the individual to donate their brain, at the time of their death, for scientific research on the underlying mechanisms of Parkinson's disease. The program, including the actual brain donation program, is free for participants. Families also receive a diagnostic report.

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
