Services include

- Balance testing using the NeuroCom Balance Master
- Balance training
- Custom wheelchair assessments
- Evaluation and fabrication of custom orthoses
- Functional mobility training
- Gait evaluations using the Gait Rite system
- Gait training
- Neuromuscular re-education
- Therapeutic exercise programs
