

Login Steps to Coeus

Here are the login steps to Coeus, the production version. If you do not have Administrator rights to your computer, you may need to have your LAN Administrator do these steps for you.

Step 1. Install the correct version of JAVA. Here's the url to do that:

Go to: http://resource.ca.jhu.edu/resource/plugin/jre1_4_2_06.exe

Step 2. Launch the PR Legacy client of Coeus.

Go to: <http://prcoeus.johnshopkins.edu/coeus/CoeusWebStart.jsp>

Coeus will check your computer to see if you have the correct version of Java, then check for any previous versions of Coeus. It will then run the Java web Start installer:

(This may take a minute or two)

You will receive a Security warning...

Select Start

You will then be asked about Desktop Integration:

I recommend answering: Yes.

Then you will be presented with the User Login Window:

use your JHED id as your User Name
and your password is initially set to: coeus (All lower case)

You will be prompted to enter a new password and to confirm it. Be sure you use a password you will remember. If you forget your password, you must email coeus-help@jhu.edu

Also, if you are not behind the Johns Hopkins University firewall, (e.g. if you are working from home), you must first create a VPN connection.
