

Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center

A full-service academic medical center on a completely modernized 130-acre campus, Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center traces its history of patient care to the founding of its ancestor, the Baltimore City and County Almshouse, in 1773; to its decades of service as an innovative municipal facility known as Baltimore City Hospitals; and to its 1984 acquisition by The Johns Hopkins Hospital. Johns Hopkins Bayview physicians hold full-time faculty positions in the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, and the medical center campus is also home to research facilities for the National Institute on Drug Abuse and the National Institute on Aging.

Nationally and Internationally Recognized Care

Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center is home to a nationally renowned geriatrics center and a state-designated Level II trauma center and Level IIIb neonatal intensive care unit that are part of the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems. The Johns Hopkins Burn Center, the only burn trauma and surgical facility in the region, is accredited by the American Burn Association and is federally designated as a model system of state-of-the-art, coordinated care for burn patients.

Part of a Premier Integrated System

Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center is a member of Johns Hopkins Medicine, one of the world's premier, integrated health systems, with six hospitals, four community-based health care and surgery centers, more than 30 primary health care sites throughout Maryland, managed care and home care services, and 17 strategic collaboration, affiliate and numerous management agreements overseas, and multiple short-term consulting projects.

Among Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center's specialty services are:

Alcohol and Drug Abuse

- Center for Addiction and Pregnancy, offering inpatient and outpatient services for mothers and their infants
- Substance abuse treatment, including daily individual and group therapy, and psychiatric and obstetric evaluation and care

Asthma and Allergy

- Asthma and Allergy Center, providing care for patients with allergies, asthma and related disorders
- Dermatology, Allergy and Clinical Immunology Reference Laboratory providing specialized diagnostic measurements to allergists, dermatologists and clinical immunologists

Bariatrics

- Designated a Center of Excellence by the American Society for Bariatric Surgery
- More than 2,200 bariatric procedures with one of the lowest complication rates in the United States
- Member of the Bariatric Surgery Network

Burn Center

- Providing care to some 400 inpatients and 1,600 outpatients each year, with a survival rate of 95 percent
- Serves as the mid-Atlantic regional burn center

Geriatrics

- Care Center, a skilled nursing facility and chronic hospital providing long-term, subacute and chronic medical care, ventilator care, rehabilitation services and outpatient care
- ElderPlus, an outpatient program coordinating care to keep older adults in their homes

- Memory and Alzheimer's Treatment Center, offering evaluation and treatment for dementias, traumatic brain injury and brain vascular disease

Orthopedics

- Cartilage Restoration Center, providing innovative ways to repair, regenerate or replace cartilage
- Joint replacement, sports medicine, and orthopedic trauma

Rheumatology

- Arthritis Center, providing treatment for rheumatoid arthritis, osteoarthritis, psoriatic arthritis, gout, fibromyalgia, lupus, Lyme disease, osteoporosis and Sjögren's syndrome
- Vasculitis Center, providing treatment for diseases involving blood vessel inflammation

Women's Health

- Women's Center for Pelvic Health, providing evaluation and treatment for pelvic floor disorders
- Cervical Disease and Colposcopy Clinic, for women with abnormal Pap smears

Other Specialty Services

- Headache Center, specializing in treatments for hundreds of types of headaches
- Myositis Center, bringing together neurologists, rheumatologists, pulmonologists, physical therapists, occupational therapists and nutritionists specializing in a rare disease that causes muscle inflammation and damage
- Metabolic Bone Center, offering services to prevent, diagnose and treat osteoporosis, fragility and recurrent fractures, vitamin D deficiency, Paget's disease and more
