



This memorandum summarizes the parking and transportation arrangements available to Third and Fourth Year Medical Students. Street parking adjacent to the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is unsafe, and students are strongly encouraged to use the parking options described in this memo. Please use the free scheduled Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions Van Service or the Shuttle Services provided by the transportation department. 1) **Parking – Garage parking provided for all 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year students**

**Garage Parking - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions**

ID badges for members of the Classes of 2010 & 2011 have been activated to permit access to either the Caroline St. garage or McElderry St. garage.

Parking utilization will be closely monitored. Parking privileges will be revoked for anyone who allows non-authorized use of an ID badge for parking.

**Parking - The Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center**

Students on rotation to Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center should report to the Parking Office, Room 1500, Triad Building to arrange for parking and to have their ID badges activated.

**FREE Garage Parking (all garages except Kennedy Krieger)- After 4:00 p.m. - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions**

Evening, nighttime (between 4:00 pm and 8:30 am), weekends and **JHH approved holidays**, parking is available to all students without cost. Swipe your ID badge to gain access and to leave the garage.

**Hours of Operation:**

Orleans St. Garage - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week  
Washington St. - 6 am - midnight, Mon. - Fri.; 7 am - 7 pm, Saturday & Sunday  
Rutland Ave. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

McElderry St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week  
Caroline St. – 24 hours/day, Monday – Friday; closed Saturday & Sunday

4) **Mass Transit Administration (MTA)**

MTA passes are available at \$20/month through the School of Medicine Office of Financial Affairs. Passes cannot be purchased during the months that any other parking services are utilized.
