This memorandum summarizes the parking and transportation arrangements available to Graduate Students. Street parking adjacent to the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is unsafe, and students are strongly encouraged to use the parking options described in this memo. 1) **Parking**

Parking services for graduate students are coordinated by Brian Simons, Graduate Student Association (GSA) Parking Representative. Please contact him at [gsaparking@jhmi.edu](mailto:gsaparking@jhmi.edu) or visit the GSA website at [www.hopkinsmedicine.org/gsa](http://www.hopkinsmedicine.org/gsa).

**Off-Site Parking** - There is no additional fee to students.

Off-Site parking is provided by the School of Medicine. Permits are assigned by the School of Medicine Office of Financial Affairs, 131 Broadway Research Building. You must present your student ID badge to obtain a parking permit. Frequent shuttle service between the School of Medicine and the parking lots is provided.

**Monument Street Lot - 3700 East Monument St. 1.3 miles east of the medical institutions campus**

Open and security provided between the hours of 6 am – 10 pm, Monday through Friday. Drop Off-Rutland Avenue at Monument. This lot is accessed through Automated Vehicle Identification (AVI) transponder and a \$20 refundable deposit is required at the time the transponder is assigned.

**Fallsway Lot - Near Monument Street and Fallsway**

Open and security provided between 6 am and 10 pm Monday through Friday. Drop off - Wolfe Street near main entrance to Hospital (limited availability).

**ON-SITE PARKING - \$115 per month-Limited Availability**

Currently students pay \$50 per month. The School of Medicine subsidizes \$65 a month.

**Kennedy Krieger Institute, Caroline, and Washington Street Garages - Limited availability**

Kennedy Krieger Garage - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Caroline St. - 24 hours/day, Monday - Friday, closed Saturday, Sunday & holidays

Washington St. - Open 6 am to 12 midnight, Monday - Friday  
7 am to 7 pm, Saturday and Sunday

**Reed Hall Residents**

A limited number of parking spaces in the McElderry Street Garage are available to graduate students who are Reed Hall residents. The current cost is \$115 per month, and permits may be purchased through the Parking Office, Nelson/Harvey Room 108. Students who choose this option are not allowed to participate in other parking/transportation programs.

**FREE Garage Parking - After 4:00 p.m. - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions**

Evening, nighttime (after 4:00 pm and before 8:30 am) and weekend parking is available to all students without cost. Scan I.D. badge to gain access and to leave the garage.

**Hours of Operation:**

Orleans St. Garage - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Rutland Ave. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

McElderry St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

4) **Mass Transit Administration (MTA)**

MTA passes are available at \$20/month through the School of Medicine Office of Financial Affairs. Passes cannot be purchased during the months that other subsidized parking is utilized.
