

Space Heaters

Space heaters are commonly used at JHI but do you know if the one you are using is approved for usage? Heaters shall be limited to devices which are of the oil-filled type only, and which are equipped with a safety switch which disconnects power if the device tips over. Use of any other type increases the risk of fire and can be removed if seen by Health, Safety, and Environment.
