POLICY

It is the Policy of the Johns Hopkins Institutions to comply with all applicable Federal State and Local Regulations

When a JHI employee dies at a JHI worksite, appropriate regulatory agencies must be notified within eight (8) hours of the death.

Maryland Occupational Safety Health (MOSH) MOSH if the worksite is in Maryland

RESPONSIBILITIES

Notify HSE manager on call immediately upon death of an JHI employee on a JHI worksite

HSE Managers

Notify MOSH or OSHA as appropriate

Notify Executive Director of HSE or Associate Director HSE as appropriate
