## Work to Keep Johns Hopkins Excellent

Our Compliance Program in conjunction with related policies and procedures are in place to detect and prevent fraud, waste and abuse and consistent with our anti-retaliation philosophy, protect those who report suspected instances of this conduct. Therefore, we rely on you to identify and report potential compliance problems.

We have written policies for all employees providing information about:

- **Federal False Claims Act** – a statute the federal government uses to hold healthcare providers accountable who submit false/inaccurate claims for medical services provided
- **State Remedies** – state statutes and rules which may be applied by state government enforcement agencies similar to the Federal False Claims Act
- **Associated Whistleblower Protections** – the commitment to protect employees from retaliation if they provide information to the government about suspected fraud, waste and abuse
