

Position available for a Postdoctoral Fellow in the Department of Medicine (Gastroenterology)

A postdoctoral position is available to determine the role of a Na/H exchanger in GI diseases.

Wanted: Post Doctoral fellow with a genetics background and interest in defining the pathophysiology of new human diseases.

We have evidence that polymorphisms of the brush border Na/H exchanger may be responsible for GI diseases with abnormal bowel function. To begin studies, we already have a data base of 500 GI patients with genomic DNA and clinical histories and want to determine whether non functional polymorphisms account for the symptoms. The funding is a recently renewed program project grant.
