A Postdoctoral Research Fellow position is available at the Division of Molecular Radiation Sciences in the Department of Radiation Oncology at John Hopkins University School of Medicine. The lab is located in the CRB II building, a new state-of-art research facility in the Hopkins East Campus. We study the cellular pathways that repair DNA double-strand breaks in mammalian cells using mouse models deficient for specific repair factors. Our research aims to establish the molecular mechanisms that ensure genomic integrity, with the long-term goal of improving the prevention and treatment of genomic instability-associated cancer and aging.

The candidate is expected to have obtained a PhD in the biological sciences. Experience in cellular and molecular biology and/or mouse genetics would be helpful, but not required.
