The International Vaccine Institute (IVI), Seoul, Korea, is seeking qualified individuals to fill research positions in its Translational Research Division. Successful applicants will be hired at the level of Associate Research Scientist.

The International Vaccine Institute (IVI) is a non-profit organization dedicated to accelerating research, evaluation and introduction of new and improved vaccines primarily in developing countries. The IVI was established under the Vienna Convention of 1969. These positions are located at the IVI headquarters in Seoul, Korea.

The IVI has research programs addressing new vaccines against rotavirus diarrhea, cholera, shigellosis, typhoid fever, Hib, pneumococcal disease, influenza, Japanese encephalitis, and dengue fever in 27 countries of Asia, Africa and Latin America.

Applicants should have backgrounds in epidemiology and /or infectious diseases, with experience in vaccinology and vaccine development and evaluation, disease surveillance and disease modeling.

Qualifications include an M.D., Ph.D. or equivalent degree and training in epidemiology and /or infectious diseases. Past research experience in performing clinical trials and in conducting studies in developing countries is highly desirable. A track record in successful publication of papers in international peer-reviewed journals is critical and past experience in successful grant-writing and fundraising for research projects is essential.

Epidemiologic/clinical evaluation or equivalent research experience is preferred.

Salary will be internationally competitive. The Institute provides appropriate fringe benefits including a housing allowance, home leave, and income tax reimbursement.
