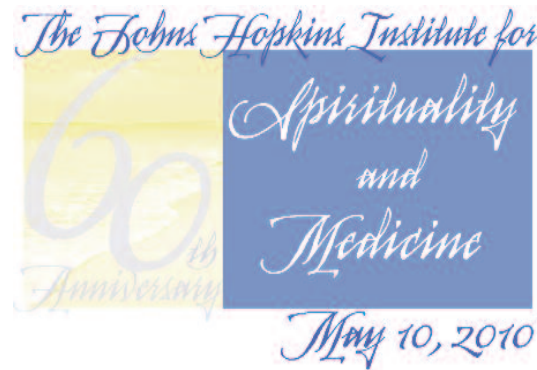


# Emerging Themes in the Integration of Spirituality and Medicine
