- Subaward Budget

■ Electronic Submissions Term (new term)

- New (same)
- Renewal
- Resubmission
- Revision
- Is equivalent to a Progress Report (box will not be used)

New Terminology

Electronic Submissions (cont)

- **New** – An application that is being submitted to an agency for the first time.
- **Renewal** – An application requesting additional funding for a period subsequent to that provided by a current award. A renewal application COMPETES with all other applications and must be developed as fully as though that applicant is applying for the first time.
- **Resubmission** – An application that has been previously submitted, but was not funded, and is being resubmitted for new consideration.
- **Revision** – An application that proposes a change in:
 - The Federal Government's financial obligations or contingent liability from an existing obligation, or
 - Any other change in the terms and conditions of the existing award.
- **Continuation** – A non-competing application for an additional funding/budget period within a previously approved project period. NIH Will not use the R&R forms for progress reports.
