**Priority Application Date: March 15, 2012**

Johns Hopkins administers both federal and institutional aid programs. As a student at a professional school, you are considered independent and you must submit financial information about yourself and your spouse.

You must be a United States citizen or permanent resident to apply for Federal Financial Aid at the School of Medicine. Institutional scholarship funding is determined by the Art as Applied to Medicine Department based on internal criteria.

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## REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIAL

1. Complete **The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine Financial Aid Application**. Submit the completed application to the Financial Aid Office. The application is located on our website at [http://www.hopkinsmedicine.org/som/offices/finaid/apply\\_for\\_aid/](http://www.hopkinsmedicine.org/som/offices/finaid/apply_for_aid/)
2. Complete the **FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**.
  - Complete the FAFSA electronically at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>
    - **Renewal FAFSA**. If you filed a FAFSA or renewal FAFSA for 2011-2012, you can save time by updating that data on the 2012-2013 renewal form. The Department of Education is no longer mailing paper renewal forms, so you must file electronically to use this option. You will need your **PIN** (Personal Identification Number). If you have forgotten your PIN, you can request a duplicate PIN at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). You can also call the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1-800-4-FED-AID for assistance.
  - For new filers, after completing your online FAFSA, the Department of Education will send you a **PIN** number. This serves as your electronic signature when you complete your renewal FAFSA for the next award year.
  - The **FAFSA school code** is **E00235** for the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.
  - Maryland State residents applying for Maryland State scholarship funding must complete the FAFSA application by the March 1, 2012. State deadline.

3. **2012-2013 FEDERAL VERIFICATION WORKSHEET and Transcript of your 2011 Federal tax return . For students selected for verification ONLY.** The Federal Verification worksheet and transcript of your 2011 Federal tax return will be required **only** if your FAFSA is selected for federal verification by the Department of Education. Your processed FAFSA application and Student Aid Report will indicate if your application has been selected. (State tax returns are not required).
