This memorandum summarizes the parking and transportation arrangements available to Third and Fourth Year Medical Students. Street parking adjacent to the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is unsafe, and students are strongly encouraged to use the parking options described in this memo. Please use the free scheduled Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions van service or the Shuttle Services provided by the transportation department. 1) Parking – Garage parking provided for all 3rd and 4th year students

Garage Parking - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions

ID badges for members of the 3rd and 4th year classes have been activated to permit access to either the Orleans St. garage or McElderry St. garage.

Parking utilization will be closely monitored. Parking privileges will be revoked for anyone who allows non-authorized use of an I.D. badge for parking.

Parking - The Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center

Students on rotation to Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center should report to the Parking Office, Room 1500, Triad Building to arrange for parking and to have their I.D. badges activated.

FREE Garage Parking (all garages) - After 4:00 p.m. - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions

Evening, nighttime (after 4:00 pm and before 8:30 am) and weekend parking is available to all students without cost. Scan I.D. badge to gain access and to leave the garage.

Hours of Operation:

Orleans St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week
Washington St. - 6 am – 12 midnight, Mon. - Fri.; 7 am - 7 pm, Saturday and Sunday
Rutland Ave. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week
McElderry St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week
Caroline St. - 5:30 am Monday - 9:00 am Saturday, Closed Saturday and Sunday
