This memorandum summarizes the parking and transportation arrangements available to Graduate Students. Street parking adjacent to the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is unsafe, and students are strongly encouraged to use the parking options described in this memo. **1) Parking**

Parking services for graduate students are coordinated by the Graduate Student Association (GSA) Parking Representative. Please contact the GSA at [gsaparking@jhmi.edu](mailto:gsaparking@jhmi.edu) or visit the GSA website at [www.hopkinsmedicine.org/gsa](http://www.hopkinsmedicine.org/gsa).

**OFF-SITE PARKING** - There is no additional fee to students.

Off-Site parking is provided by the School of Medicine. Permits are assigned by the School of Medicine Office of Financial Affairs, 131 Broadway Research Building. You must present your student I.D. badge to obtain a parking permit. Frequent shuttle service between the School of Medicine and the parking lots is provided.

Monument Street Lot - 3700 East Monument St., 1.3 miles east of the medical institution campus  
This is a surface lot with security provided between the hours of 6 am - 10 pm, Monday through Friday. Drop Off is at Rutland Avenue at Monument St. This lot is accessed by swiping your I.D. badge.

Fallsway Lot - Near Monument Street and Fallsway  
This is a surface lot with security provided between 6 am - 10 pm Monday through Friday. Drop off is at Wolfe Street near main entrance to Hospital (limited availability).

**ON-SITE PARKING** – There are a limited number of parking spaces available on campus. The rate is \$120 per month. Permits for all on-site parking are purchased through the Parking Office, Nelson/Harvey Room 108.

Caroline Street Garage – open around the clock from 5:30 a.m. Monday through 9:00 a.m. Saturday, Closed Saturday and Sunday

Washington Street Garage - open 6 am-12 midnight, Monday-Friday; 7 am-7 pm, Saturday and Sunday

### GSA Parking Subsidy

The GSA has access to a limited number of parking spaces on campus that are subsidized by the School of Medicine, such that the student pays \$55 per month rather than \$120 per month. Contact the GSA for availability at [gsaparking@jhmi.edu](mailto:gsaparking@jhmi.edu). Students who have subsidized parking are not allowed to participate in other parking/transportation programs.

### Reed Hall Residents

Reed Hall residents have guaranteed access to park on-site in the McElderry Street Garage. Subsidized parking may be available; contact the GSA directly at [gsaparking@jhmi.edu](mailto:gsaparking@jhmi.edu) for availability.

### Other Garage Availability

FREE Garage Parking - After 4:00 p.m. - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions

Evening, nighttime (after 4:00 pm and before 8:30 am) and weekend parking is available to all students without cost. Scan I.D. badge to gain access and to leave the garage.

McElderry St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Orleans St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Rutland Ave. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

## **4) Mass Transit Administration (MTA)**
