The tables below provide estimated average charges for common inpatient and outpatient procedures at The Johns Hopkins Hospital. These tables are updated quarterly and are based on the patient charges actually incurred for these services during the previous twelve months. They may be used by patients to estimate the charge for services that they may incur.

Please note that these are only estimates and are subject to change without notice. The actual cost of your procedure may be higher or lower based on factors specific to your case, such as your length of stay in the hospital and the complexity of your medical condition. These estimates reflect hospital charges only. They do not include physician or other provider fees that are billed separately from the hospital fees.
