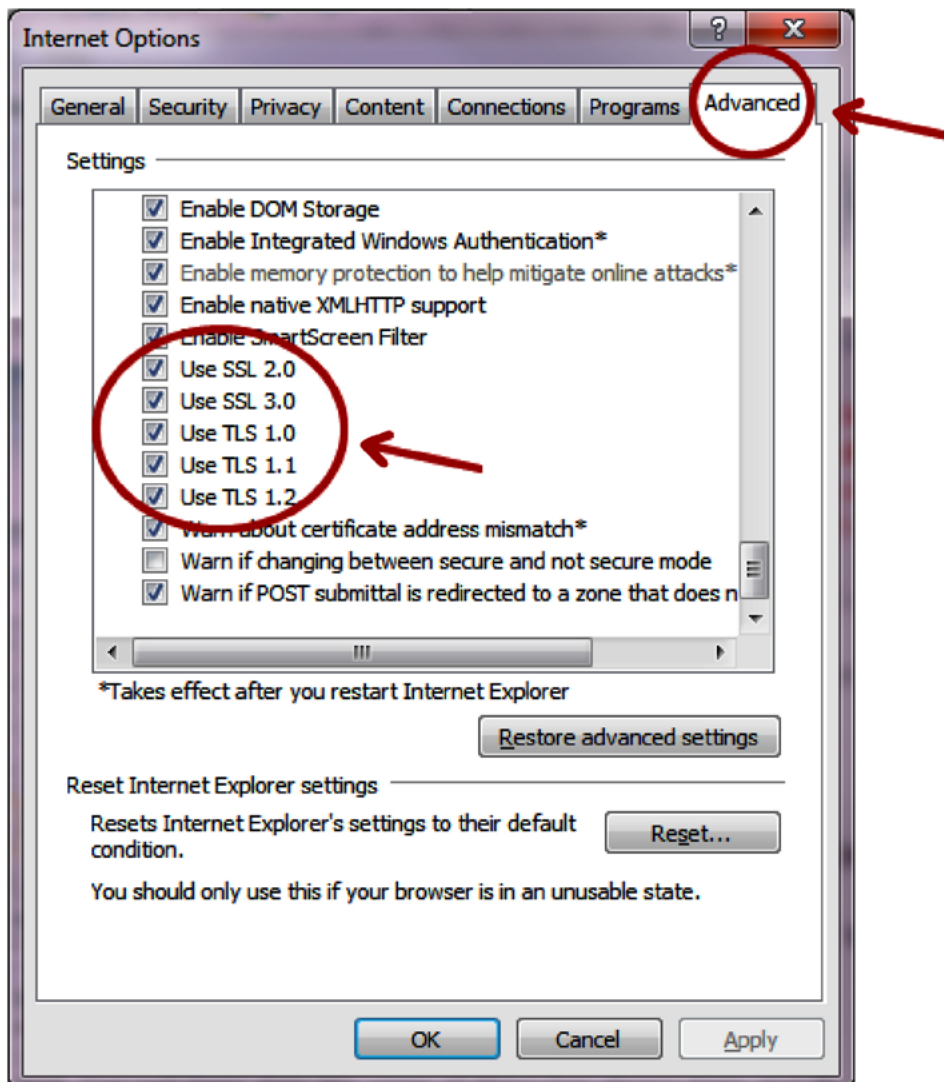


How to apply Internet Explorer browser settings for the the USFHP “Find a Provider” page.

- 1.) Open your Internet Explorer (browser)
- 2.) Go to “Tools”
- 3.) Then “Internet Options”
- 4.) Hit the “Advanced” tab (like image below)

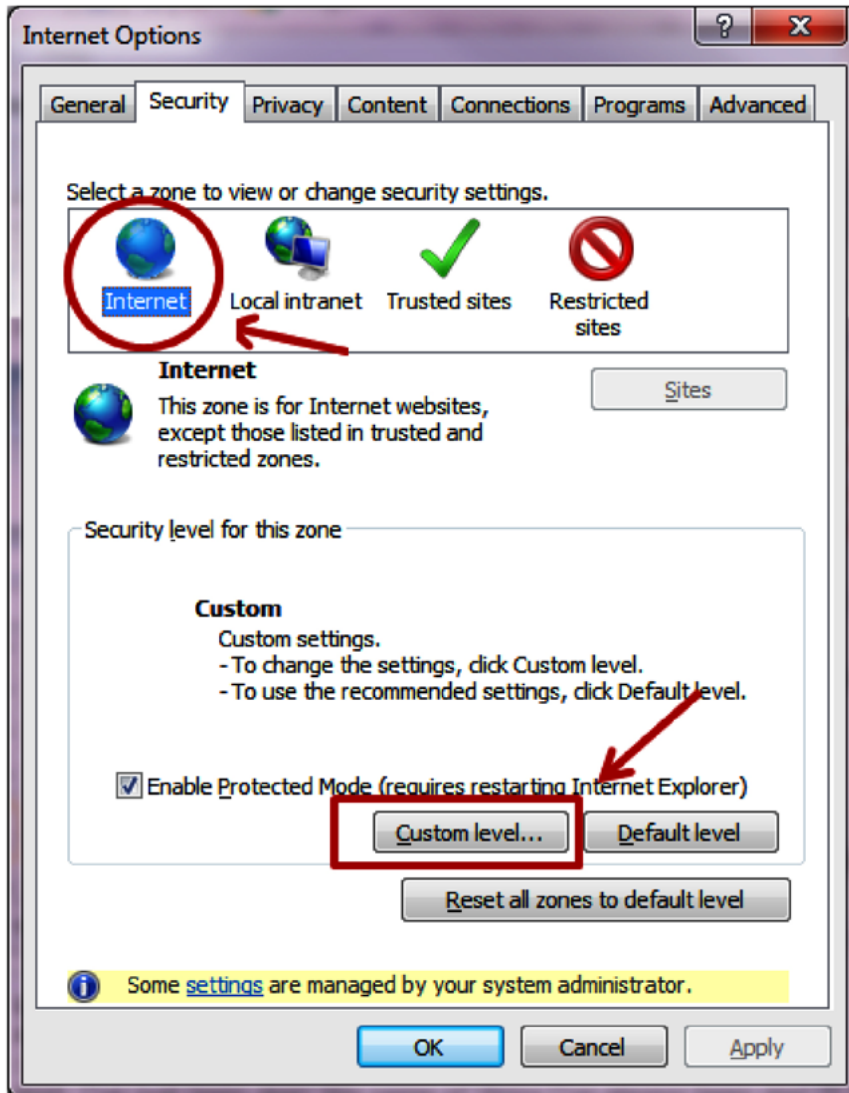
* Check on all the boxes that are available that start with either: **Use SSL** and **Use TLS** like the image below.

Note: You might not have as many under your tab.



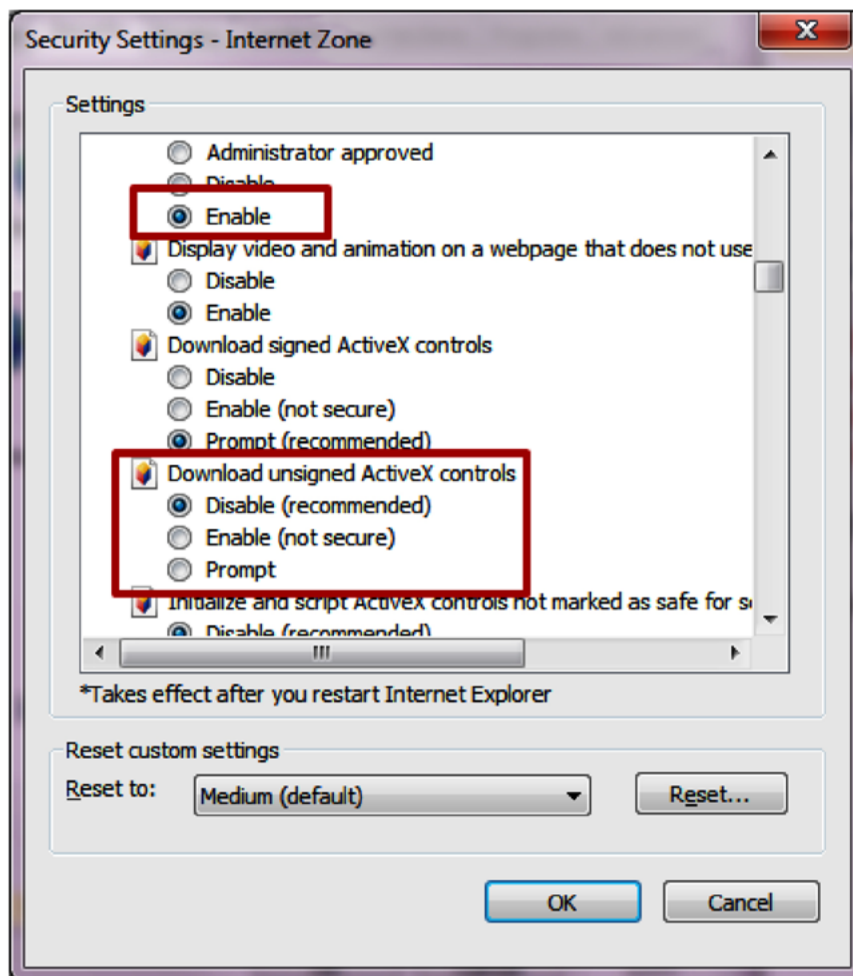
In the same window you will see a “Security” tab.
Click on that.

* Highlight “Internet”, then click on “Custom level”...
(as indicated in image below).



From the “Custom level” tab

- * Scroll down to find the “ActiveX controls and plug-ins” topic.
 - 1.) Enable it (see image below)
- * Notice the “Downloaded unsigned ActiveX controls.”
 - 2.) Disable (recommended) (see image below)



Still in “Security Settings”

* Scroll down to “Miscellaneous”.

I.) Access data sources across domains - Enable it. (see image below)

* Then click “OK” to exit

NOTE: After clicking “OK”, Close your browser and restart it and try the USFHP “Find a Provider” page again.
