Local Accommodations

Housing Options to Consider in Baltimore

The **Oncology Housing Referral Service, 410-614-6527**, is available to provide housing information to patients and their families who require temporary housing while receiving treatment at the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center at Johns Hopkins.

While in Baltimore, there are several housing options you can choose from:

- Hotels- Advance reservations and numerous locations in and around the Baltimore area
- Furnished apartments- Advance reservations, offer monthly rental options, numerous locations in and around the Baltimore area
- Accommodations specifically for cancer patients – Operate via a “waiting list” policy - you may not have a confirmed room at the accommodations listed below until as late as the day prior to your arrival:
 - o The Hackerman-Patz Patient and Family Pavilion - located on the Hospital Campus
 - o The American Cancer Society Hope Lodge - located in downtown Baltimore (Approx 2 miles from the Hospital campus)

Please refer to the *Temporary Housing Options* listing enclosed which provides more detailed information about local accommodations. Please call the facility directly if you have specific questions.

BMT, Radiation, Chemotherapy Patients:

**PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION
BEFORE YOU MAKE HOUSING ARRANGEMENTS**

Patients undergoing any type of treatment are required to follow important medically based guidelines regarding housing/local accommodations during the outpatient phase of the process. Your BMT Case Manager or Physician can review these guidelines with you. Before you make your housing arrangements, please review these guidelines with your BMT Case Manager or Physician.

It is medically recommended that BMT patients avoid construction, open excavation sites, or other dust-laden environments for the first 6 months after transplant.

IF YOU LIVE MORE THAN 60 MINUTES FROM THE HOSPITAL

You can make local housing arrangements for the time you will be receiving your outpatient care (unless otherwise indicated by your physician). The Oncology Housing Referral Service (410-614-6527) is available to provide you with information about local housing options. **You are responsible for making these arrangements prior to your treatment.** Your social worker is available to help problem-solve any concerns you may have. Please call Oncology Social Work at 410-955-8934 to speak with your social worker.

IF YOU LIVE LESS THAN 60 MINUTES FROM THE HOSPITAL

You may return to your own home unless otherwise indicated by your physician. Your BMT case manager or physician can discuss the guidelines and your specific case with you.

Helpful Information for Planning Your Stay:

- The patient will need to check with your health insurance company to determine if there is any coverage through your policy for local housing related to your transplant or treatment.
- As a Johns Hopkins patient or family member, you have access to reduced rates at many local hotels (See the enclosed list).
- Consider the special needs of any family members or caretakers who will also need housing.
- Some lower-cost housing accommodations operate via a “waiting list.” This means that the accommodation cannot confirm a reservation ahead of time; often room availabilities are known as late as the day prior to your arrival. (The sooner you can provide the dates that you expect to need housing, the better the chance you will have in locating a room.)
- If you are on a waiting list, be sure to have a back-up plan (i.e. local hotel reservation). This is important in case the accommodation cannot have a room for you on your requested arrival date. When making any hotel reservations, please be sure to ask about their cancellation policy.
- Some accommodations do not have elevators or other specific arrangements. If you or someone you will be traveling with requires handicapped accessible housing, please clarify that the accommodation is accessible.
- Most housing accommodations require guests to be able to independently take care of themselves or have a caregiver stay with them. If you need assistance, you may need to have a caregiver stay with you during the whole treatment.
- If you are looking for a room for you and a child, please be sure to verify the age requirements of each accommodation. Each accommodation has specific policies regarding children.
- If you or your family prefers specific amenities during your stay, be sure to clarify what amenities are offered at each facility. It is important to match what you require with an appropriate facility. Some accommodations may not have daily housekeeping services, restaurants, or concierge services.
- A few accommodations restrict the number of rooms one family can occupy. Be sure to clarify your needs beforehand. If you have hired a caregiver to assist you while in Baltimore, a separate room may be required.

The above information is intended to assist you and your family in preparation for arranging housing accommodations. Deciding where you would prefer to stay while in Baltimore is an important, personal decision for you and your family.
