How to Be an Ally

- Anti-Defamation League.
 - Anti-Semitism: 90 Ways You Can Respond
 - <u>Support Jewish employees</u>
 - Create a safe space for impacted employees to gather and get support from one another. Allow for appropriate use of bereavement leave, or similar PTO policies.
 - Reach out to your Jewish ERG or affinity group, if your company already has one, to express support and offer to hold space for them to connect.
 - If your company does not already have an ERG or affinity group, <u>share an</u> <u>overview of what a Jewish ERG or affinity group</u> would offer to your staff, and consider opening a space for the community.
 - Educate
 - Create a mechanism for employees to learn more from trusted resources, and conduct your own research the topic at hand so that the onus of education does not fall on the community that needs support. A sampling of shareable resources can be found here:
