### Observation Criteria

Staff members must wear surgical masks from the time sterile supplies are opened and throughout the entire surgical procedure.  
 (All surgical masks must be secured with both ties and completely covering the nose and mouth)  
 Staff must have all head and facial hair, including sideburns completely covered when in the semi-restricted and restricted areas. (Cloth hats must be covered with a surgical cap)  
 Jewelry must be totally confined or removed  
 If the surgical hand scrub was observed, was it performed properly? (See proper procedure on additional form)  
 If patient skin prep was observed, was it performed properly?
