WEEKLY EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE LOG

Standard Eyewashes, Drench Hoses, and Combination Units

- Equipment must be run WEEKLY for at least 3 minutes or until the water is sediment-free.
- The equipment must be unobstructed
- Water must come on within one second of activation.
- Water must be tepid (60F 100F: cool warm to touch).
- Water must have adequate pressure (for eyewashes, flow should be at least 2" and must be less than 8"above the eyewash).
- Eyewash caps must be clean and not require a separate motion to remove (they must fall off when the eyewash is activated)
- Clean nozzles as needed to keep them free of mineral deposits.
