Stronger magnetic strength available, I.5T – 3T.



Higher image quality, often avoids need for rescan due to image issues.



Able to complete scans more quickly.



Wide-bore options available with an increased 70cm opening.

Open MRI



Weaker magnetic strength, .2T – I.2T.



Reduced image quality, could require rescan. Not optimal for small structures.



Can take up to twice as long to complete a scan with lower quality results.



The same type of scanning equipment, including head coils if needed, are used.
