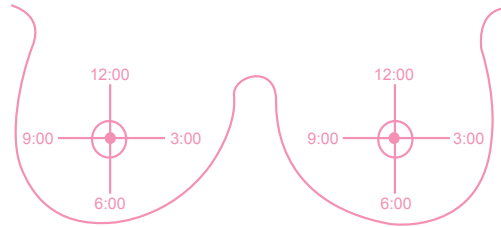

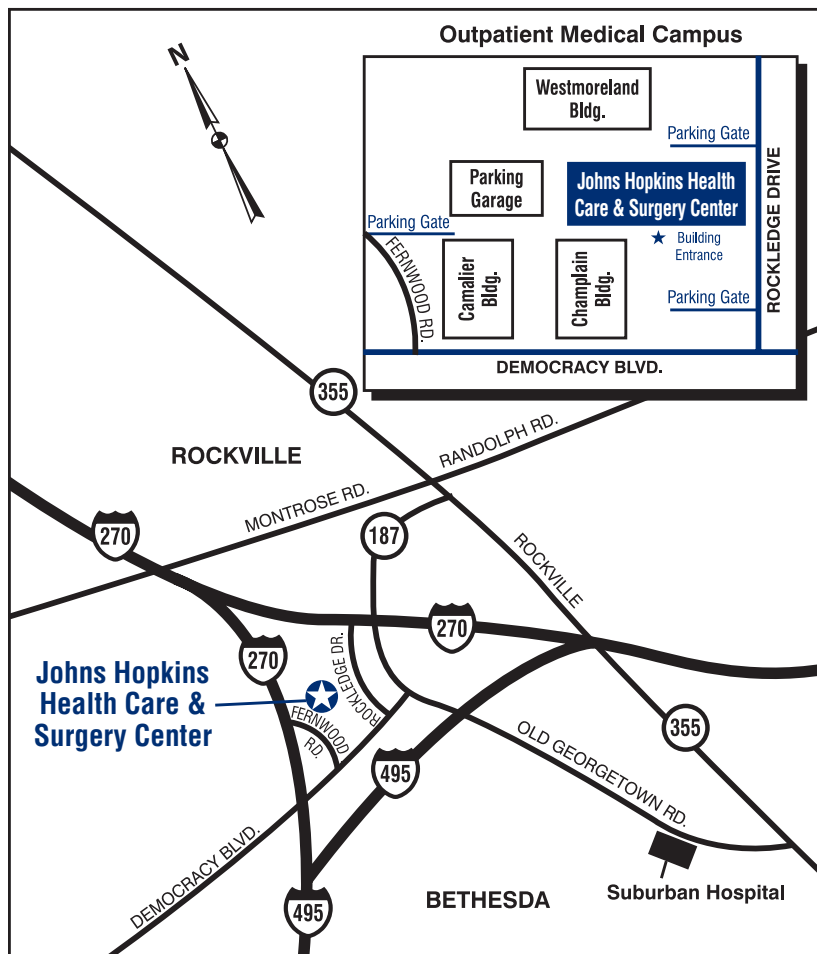

## Exam Preparations:

### MAMMOGRAMS AND DIGITAL MAMMOGRAPHY

If you've previously had mammograms at different imaging centers outside of Johns Hopkins, we can help transfer your prior records and images over to ensure smooth and integrated health care, call 410-538-2705 to find out more. Do not use perfume, deodorant, powder or lotions on the breasts or underarm area. Two piece outfits are recommended. **Please bring previous mammograms or other breast studies if they were done at another institution or arrange to have them sent to our office**

### DEXA SCAN

- Do not take any calcium supplements or any items that contain calcium, such as multi-vitamins, certain antacids products, such as Tums for 24 hours prior to your examination.
- If you have had any contrast studies within 7 days prior to your appointment, please call 443-997-7237 to reschedule the appointment.
- If you wear any type of continuous blood glucose monitor and/or an insulin/medication pump you may be asked to remove it prior to entering the imaging room. Please contact your provider or device manufacturer for additional questions and information.

### PELVIC, GYN OR OBSTETRICAL ULTRASOUND

- Must Drink 24 ounces of liquid 1 hour prior to appointment time. Do NOT empty your bladder.
