Cardiac CT Calcium Score

Thank you for choosing Johns Hopkins Medical Imaging for your upcoming exam. Your images will be reviewed by Johns Hopkins radiology experts in cardiac studies.

Background:

- A Cardiac CT Calcium Score exam is a painless 10-minute scan to evaluate the amount of hard (calcified) plaque in your heart vessels.
- Results from this exam can serve as an important risk marker and help guide decisions about your health such as using or decreasing cholesterol reducing medications.
- If this exam is not covered by insurance, it is \$75 out-of-pocket.

Before Your Exam:

- Twelve (12) hours before your scan: Do not take in any caffeine.
- Please follow any additional instructions if you are receiving any other testing on the same day.

During Your Exam:

- A CT scanner will use x-rays to create detailed images of organs and soft tissue.
- You will be able to communicate with your CT technologist during the entire exam.
- A detailed report will be sent to your referring provider who will answer any questions about your results. You can also see the report online through Johns Hopkins MyChart.
