Q: I have a patient who has had 3 years of stable follow-up diagnostic mammograms after a breast cancer diagnosis. Are there any changes to the appointments?

A: Yes, your patient now qualifies for screening mammogram appointments instead of diagnostic mammograms. If they are stable after 3 years, they are considered to be lower risk and can take advantage of more appointment options and online scheduling. We will take care of notifying the patient of this during their diagnostic mammogram appointment and answer any questions they might have about the transition.
