Nominate them for a DAISY Award®!

The DAISY Award for Extraordinary Nurses is an international program that honors the superhuman work nurses do for patients and families every day.

- All licensed nurses who demonstrate extraordinary, compassionate care are eligible, including RNs, LPNs, LVNs and advanced practice nurses.
- Nominees may work in any setting (inpatient or ambulatory).
- Nurses may be nominated by patients, families, faculty or staff members.
- Each nomination should provide details about how the nurse:
 - Models empathy and compassion
 - O Demonstrates extraordinary clinical skills
 - O Has a positive attitude and demonstrates professionalism
 - Exemplifies the mission, vision and values of Johns Hopkins Bayview

Nominations for Johns Hopkins Bayview nurses will be reviewed internally by a review committee at the Medical Center.
