## Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center Student Nurse Externship Opportunity

The Student Nurse Externship Program is a paid eight-week mentored program for nursing students (June 6, 2022 – July 30, 2022). Students practice the skills they've learned throughout the year, while developing new talents in the process. A hands-on curriculum is complemented with classroom presentations.

On the unit and in the classroom, nursing students at the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center are continually learning to improve both their careers and the care they provide. Surrounded by experienced and caring staff and guided by a personal RN mentor, students achieve the level of excellence that is the Hopkins standard.

## Qualifications

To participate in the program, students are required to have:

- At least a 3.0 GPA
- Nursing Fundamentals completed
- A minimum of one clinical rotation completed (by the start of the program in June)
- Current enrollment in an accredited nursing program
- Ability to work flexible shifts and weekends during the summer months

## **Application Process**

To apply, students must submit:

- A completed online application (jobs.hopkinsmedicine.org, requisition # 437986)
- Upload an updated resume

If selected for the program, the following documents must be provided prior to start date:

- Current transcript
- Current CPR card
- MD CNA certification (or proof of application for CNA certification)

The application deadline is **February 2, 2022.** Applicants who best meet the requirements and have submitted all necessary paperwork will be contacted for a virtual or phone interview.
