- ✓ Immediate access to a neonatologist for consults or transport requests 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year
- ✓ Access to the full spectrum of pediatric medical and surgical subspecialties: cardiology, neurology, neurosurgery, ENT, pulmonology, nephrology, ECMO, high frequency ventilation, and many more
- ✓ Active cooling in transport for patients with neonatal encephalopathy
- ✓ Staffing by specially trained neonatal transport nurses and NNPs with over 120 combined years of experience in taking care of the most critically ill neonates
- ✓ Return transport to birth hospital if warranted
- ✓ Neurodevelopmental follow-up care
- ✓ Continuing community outreach and education
