

Provider Update

This update contains pertinent information about changes that will impact the Johns Hopkins HealthCare provider network.

Johns Hopkins Employer Health Programs (EHP)

We would like to make you aware of EHP benefit and plan changes that go into effect January 1, 2019. These include new additions to the preferred provider network for the PPO plan and a new EPO offering. Complete schedules for all 2019 benefits are available on jhhc.com.

New Plan Offering — Exclusive Provider Organization (EPO) Plan

- EHP introduces a new EPO (Exclusive Provider Organization) plan on 1/1/2019. This plan will have only in-network benefits — EHP network (including Multiplan out-of-state network*) and Johns Hopkins Preferred Network (including GBMC and AAMC facilities and providers). Care outside the EHP network is not covered under the EPO, except for emergency care.

- o Applies to: **Johns Hopkins Health System, Johns Hopkins Hospital, Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center, Howard County General Hospital and Suburban Hospital**

New Additions to the Hopkins Preferred Provider Network

- Greater Baltimore Medical Center (GBMC) and Anne Arundel Medical Center (AAMC) facilities and providers will join the Johns Hopkins Preferred Provider Network on 1/1/2019.

- Applies to **Johns Hopkins Health System, Johns Hopkins Hospital, Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center** —Providers and Facilities (PPO and EPO)

Howard County General Hospital, Suburban Hospital and Sibley Hospital

—Facilities only (PPO and EPO)
