Prior Authorization

Providers seeking to perform these services will need to submit a prior authorization request to Johns Hopkins HealthCare (JHHC) via fax at 855-704-5296. The prior authorization request should include all pertinent clinical information to support medical necessity.

Services Already Scheduled for 2018

For services already scheduled after March 1, 2018, please submit the prior authorization request to JHHC by fax as soon as possible. Failure to obtain a prior authorization may result in a denial of payment.
