



Reminder: New Prior Authorization Requirements For Certain Provider-Administered Medications

Effective Date: Feb. 15, 2026

Health Plans Affected: Advantage MD, Employer Health Programs (EHP), Priority Partners

Type of Change: Process

Explanation of Change: Effective Feb. 15, 2026, Johns Hopkins Health Plans will require prior authorization to determine medical necessity for several provider-administered medications under Priority Partners, EHP and Advantage MD. These requirements affect members of all ages.
