



Go-Live Date Now April 18 for Availity Accepting Electronic Medical Records and Itemized Bills

Effective Date: April 18, 2026

Health Plans Affected: Advantage MD, Employer Health Programs (EHP), Priority Partners

Type of Change: Provider Portal Upgrades

Explanation of Change:

Starting April 18, 2026, Johns Hopkins Health Plans will accept electronic medical records and itemized bills through [Availity](#), our secure provider portal. NOTE: Electronic submission through [Availity](#) will continue to be excluded for Johns Hopkins US Family Health Plan providers.

All facility claims with billed charges exceeding \$75,000 will require the itemized bill and medical records to be submitted with the claim.

Failure to submit itemized bills and supporting medical records for billed charges exceeding \$75,000 will result in rejected claims.

Providers may attach a medical record and/or an itemized bill for any claim, regardless of billed amount, as additional information. Additionally, Johns Hopkins Health Plans may also occasionally ask for an itemized bill and/or medical record to help clarify or pay a claim more accurately.
