



New Prior Authorization Requirements For Certain Provider-Administered Medications

Effective Date: May 22, 2026

Health Plans Affected: Priority Partners

Type of Change: Prior Authorization

Explanation of Change:

Effective May 22, 2026, Johns Hopkins Health Plans will require prior authorization to determine medical necessity for select provider-administered medications under Priority Partners. In addition to medical necessity, some drug HCPCS codes may require site of service (site of care) prior authorization. These requirements affect members of all ages.
