Provider-Administered Medication Policy Updates Effective on or after July 1, 2021

JHHC has adopted several clinical policies for use in the prior authorization review of select provideradministered medications. The use of these policies will go into effect on July 1, 2021 for Priority Partners and July 15, 2021 for Johns Hopkins Employer Health Programs (EHP), and Johns Hopkins Advantage MD.
