

Correction: Colorectal Cancer Screening Expansion to Age 45

Effective Date: July 1, 2022

Health Plans Affected: Johns Hopkins Employer Health Programs (EHP), Priority Partners, Johns Hopkins US Family Health Plan (USFHP)

Type of Change: Benefit

Explanation of Change: Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA) preventive screenings program, colorectal cancer screenings are covered for males and females beginning at age 45, no prior authorization or referral required. Individuals under age 45 are covered with increased risk diagnosis code with no prior authorization or referral. This provision is effective July 1, 2022.

NOTE: Due to a data error, the codes for sigmoidoscopy and colonoscopy were omitted. The restored codes appear below in RED.
