New Prior Authorization Requirements For Certain Provider-Administered Medications

Effective March 1, 2023, Johns Hopkins HealthCare will require prior authorization to determine medical necessity for several provider-administered medications under the Priority Partners health plan. This requirement affects members of all ages.
