Explanation of Change:

Effective March 17, 2023, Johns Hopkins HealthCare will require prior authorization for select new lab procedure codes for Priority Partners.

List of procedure codes requiring prior authorization*

This list is provided for reference purposes only. The prior authorization requirement applies to Priority Partners members of all ages.

For prior authorization through eviCore, providers should submit prior authorization requests via the eviCore portal through <u>HealthLINK</u>, directly through the <u>eviCore portal*</u>, or, if the portal cannot be accessed, by calling eviCore at **866-220-3071**.
