Availity Essentials is a secure, real-time platform that connects providers with payers to help providers manage medical benefits and insurance claims. We are introducing Availity Essentials as part of our continuing effort to boost efficiency and streamline processes.

Starting Oct. 21, 2023, the first phase of the Availity Essentials portal implementation will be available for Priority Partners, Advantage MD and EHP providers (US Family Health Plan will be added to the portal in 2024). Features include:

- Member eligibility requests and benefit information
- Electronic claims submission
- Claims status
- Remittance and claims payment information
- Insights into financial and administrative transactions

In addition, Availity Essentials will offer the following resources:

- In the News and Announcements tab, providers can keep up to date on our communications and provider education presentations.
