2018 Cost Shares for USFHP Members

As a result of changes to the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), effective Jan. 1, 2018, there will be some changes to TRICARE Prime Cost Shares.

Group A includes those members who enlist before Jan. 1, 2018, and their dependents Group B includes those members who enlist after Jan. 1, 2018 (or become medically retired) and their dependents

Catastrophic Cap

Payments that would typically count toward catastrophic caps and deductibles until Oct. 1, 2017, will continue to count until Jan. 1, 2018. Effective Jan. 1, 2018, deductibles and catastrophic caps will be calculated on a calendar year basis.
