Johns Hopkins Advantage MD Whole Health Assessment (WHA) Form Goes Digital

Starting November 5, 2018, the JH Advantage MD Whole Health Assessment (WHA) form will be available in a digital format for Advantage MD providers through HealthLINK and on <u>jhhc.com</u>. No more faxing or snail mail—just fill out the form and submit electronically.

The link to the WHA form is: Whole Health Assessment (Online Form).

Providers can also access the WHA form by logging into HealthLINK, and through the JHHC Providers and Physicians web portal in the <u>"Forms"</u> section.

The WHA form will still be available in a PDF format and accepted on paper via fax for those providers who are unable to submit forms electronically. Providers are not required to use the digital form at this time; however, it is the preferred method for sending in WHA forms going forward.

Advantages of Going Digital With WHAs:

- It saves money on paper and faxing costs.
- It lowers administrative expenses and staff time downloading, filling out, faxing, storing and shredding paper forms.
- It leaves a smaller carbon footprint.
- It leads to less back and forth between JHHC and providers trying to resolve errors with lost faxes or missing or incomplete information.
- Submitting WHAs electronically results in better protection of private health information.
- You can receive credit quickly for completing the WHA form through this streamlined process.
