SWIM ACROSS AMERICA CELEBRATES 10 YEARS IN THE BALTIMORE AREA \$3.4 Million Donated to the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center at Johns Hopkins

Pool Swim to be Held Saturday, September 14th at Meadowbrook in Mount Washington; Open Water Swim on Sunday, September 15th at Hide Tide Farm in Pasadena

July 11, 2019, Baltimore, MD – Celebrating a decade of support for groundbreaking cancer research, Swim Across America-Baltimore brings together swimmers of all ages and skill levels, including Olympians, with grassroots fundraising. Making a splash in Maryland 10 years ago, the organization has donated \$3.4 million to the Johns Hopkins Sidney Kimmel Cancer Center for clinical trials in immunotherapy, genomic-based testing and the creation of a dedicated cancer survivorship program.

This year's pool swim is scheduled for Saturday, September 14th at the Meadowbrook Swim Club in the Mount Washington-area of Baltimore with the open water swim taking place the following day on Sunday, September 15th at High Tide Farm in Pasadena, MD.

Meadowbrook Swim Club has supported the event since it started in Baltimore in 2010, donating the facilities each year for the pool swim and offering a free, 16-week training program for participants.
