

Toy Donation Safety Guidelines

In order to maintain a safe environment for our patients and families, <u>all donations must be new, odor-free, in original packaging and purchased within the last 6 months.</u>

We *cannot* accept the following:

- Used (including gently used) toys or clothing
- Toys or stuffed animals that have been exposed to smoke
- Collector items that have been gathered and stored over a significant period of time (sports cards, Beanie Babies, etc.)
- Handmade get-well cards, greeting cards and holiday cards Items containing latex (balloons, rubber balls, art supplies, etc.)
- Violent themed items (items containing guns, knives, swords, blood, violence, etc.)
- Racially and/or culturally insensitive items
- Gift wrapped items
- Religious themed items or messages
- Medical supplies or equipment
- Food, candy, beverages, etc.
