

# Abstract for Evidence-Based Practice Projects

The Johns Hopkins Center for Nursing Inquiry invites you to submit an abstract for the 2024 SHINE Conference. We are seeking submissions showcasing nurse-led, inquiry work. Use this form to write an abstract for evidence-based practice projects.

## Instructions:

- 1) Complete this form by clicking the text fields and adding text.
- 2) Each text field has a character limit to indicate the maximum number of characters that can be entered into that field. There is no need to count characters. You will not be able to exceed the character limit.
- 3) Do not include any identifying information in your abstract, such as names, affiliations, units, or cities. For example, do not refer to the location of your project as "Bloomberg 9N" or "The Johns Hopkins Hospital"; refer to the location of your project as "a pediatric unit" or "a large, urban hospital".
- 4) To save the completed form, choose "Save As" from the file menu and rename the file.
- 5) Upload the completed form to your application.

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## Title

*Indicate the name of your project. Your title should clear, concise, and reflect the focus of your project.*

## Introduction

*Describe the practice problem and the risks of not addressing the problem.*  
Character Limit: 575

**Practice Question**

*Indicate the EBP question being addressed using the Population, Intervention, Comparison, and Outcome (PICO) format.*

Character Limit: 225

**Search Strategy**

*Describe the sources used in the evidence search (e.g. databases, clinical practice guidelines, etc.), the inclusion and exclusion criteria, and date ranges.*

Character Limit: 400

**Level and Quality of Evidence**

*Provide the total number of articles retrieved from the literature search and screened by the EBP team. Include the final number of articles summarized by the team at each level with their corresponding quality rating (e.g. one level IA, three level IIA, etc.).*

Character Limit: 400

**Synthesis and Best-Evidence Recommendations**

*Synthesize the findings of the evidence review, and your corresponding best-evidence recommendations. Indicate the overall characteristics of the evidence (e.g. strong and compelling, good and consistent, good but inconsistent, or little to none).*

Character Limit: 750

**Translation**

*Describe the organization-specific recommendations and action plan, including considerations of risk, fit, feasibility, acceptability, and stakeholder engagement.*

Character Limit: 575

**Implementation (if applicable)**

*If the recommendations have been implemented, report on relevant outcomes. Write N/A if the recommendations have not yet been implemented.*

Character Limit: 575

## References

List the recent, relevant and high-quality evidence used to write your abstract (e.g. peer-reviewed articles, clinical guidelines, expert opinion, textbooks, organization policies/procedures, etc.). Evidence should be published within the past 3-5 years. You may also include seminal works. References should be cited using APA format.
