The Clozapine Clinic is an outpatient program that provides mental health services for adults who are currently taking clozapine or who would like to start clozapine treatment. Providers are experienced in all aspects of treatment with an emphasis on identifying and treating possible side effects. They also specialize in initiating clozapine in the outpatient setting, which can result in fewer hospitalizations.

In addition, clients have access to psychiatry services at Johns Hopkins Bayview, which includes various psychosocial rehabilitation programs, intensive outpatient programs, and the resources of the Adult Schizophrenia Clinic.
