

TOEFL/IELTS Exception Policy:

(Part A) International applicants with citizenship in countries where English is the official language are exempt from the English language test requirement. Below is a list of the qualifying countries and programs. If your country is not listed here, you are required to submit either TOEFL or IELTS test scores.
